Dear Friend

Saint Luke's Anglican Church has stood at the crossroads of Yea's local community for 150 years. As the oldest continually used church building in Yea, St. Luke's has ministered to people through the ravages of two World Wars, other wars, bushfires and floods. It has seen countless weddings, baptisms and funerals. Many families in the Yea district have had association with St. Luke's for many generations, the church has been an integral part of their family life in sadness and joy.

St. Luke's has been a place of peace, prayer and beauty enjoyed by congregations, visitors and the wider community for generations. It is open every day for all who seek a place of quiet refuge in the heart of Yea. The challenge facing us, is to ensure St. Luke's remains a place of welcome, ministry and outreach in the wider community for generations to come.

We have partnered with the National Trust of Australia (Victoria) and have engaged renowned church architects Lovell Chen who have wide experience which church building restoration. Their report reveals that St Luke's is suffering the from significant stress and damage to its plasterwork and stained glass windows, damp incursions, roof issues, and some structural concerns due to aging. The total cost of the restoration is approximately \$560,000.

A copy of the Lovell Chen report is available at St Luke's for viewing at the church and on the website.

It is easy to be overwhelmed by the enormity of this project however St. Luke's is already moving forward. This year, we have been able to restore the two windows at a cost of \$30,000. The Ferguson & Urie window dated 1868 is one of the earliest church stained glass windows in Victoria. The Brooks, Robinson & Co window was installed in the 1950's. The work was done by Honeysuckle Stained Glass in Bendigo.

Now we are looking to the next priority – the roof – which will stabilise the structure of the building and protect it from further water damage. Lovell Chen estimate this work will cost around 160,000 subject to conditions revealed after the removal of the current tin roof.

St. Luke's parish is appealing for financial assistance to restore and maintain our historic church.

St Luke's in the Community

St. Luke's offers:-

- Regular church services.
- KidsClub on Wednesday afternoon.
- Monthly Seniors Luncheon.
- Provides a venue for the weekly Community Meal and other community activities.
- Our current priest is the Police Chaplain to ten police stations, including our local stations of Yea, Kinglake, Alexandra and Marysville, and St. Luke's supports this ministry.
- St. Luke's co-ordinates the Christmas Hampers that are distributed to over sixty local families and individuals. In 2017 the Christmas Hampers benefitted 94 adults, 13 teenagers and 34 children.
- Through our Op Shop we further reach out into the community, being a place of connection and conversation and through the annual donation of money and goods to local people, groups and organisations.

How to make a donation

Assistance can be provided in a number of ways:-
